Topical Issues

- Council has been actively pursuing grant funding for various works, including the following applications.
 - o Footpath/blisters at Intsn. Church, Lindsay and Carcoar Streets, NSW Government RMS Walking and Cycling Communities Program.
 - o Shared path linkage extensions, NSW Government RMS Walking, and Cycling Communities Program.
 - o Errowanbang Road, Cadia Southern Transport link NSW Government Fixing Country Roads

Projects have been identified by way of project priority lists, and Councils Long Term Financial Plan/Asset Management Plans.

- A community engagement meeting was held with residents of Queen Street to consider traffic management issues associated with the proposed residential development. This matter is subject to a separate report.
- Council is part of a 2 year pilot program being undertaken in conjunction with Institute of Public Works Engineers (IPWEA) and Australian Road Research Board (ARRB Group), and another Council in each of Victoria and Queensland to study and develop modelling around gravel road deterioration. Council has been provided with a "rough o meter" to measure and report on unsealed road roughness, which will also be used across the network for condition monitoring.

Major Works

Major road construction and notes on current works are as follows:

- Hobbys Yards Road Work has been completed, awaiting line marking contractors.
- Forest Reefs Road Council has received acceptance from all land holders and is preparing for commencement of construction works early in 2015.
- Errowanbang Road Council has commenced construction, with quotations for survey works currently being considered.
- RMCC, Park Street, Millthorpe Works are to be undertaken in January to rehabilitate a segment of Park Street in the vicinity of Redmond Oval. Vegetation management works of the existing London Plane trees will be required. Noting the significance of the trees to the village amenity, Council and RMS have commenced community engagement to discuss any concerns.
- Heavy patching program Work has been completed, awaiting line marking contractors.
- Resealing program Council is currently undertaking drainage works alongside identified segments in preparation for undertaking of reseals in February 2015.

Major Contracts

Cowriga Creek Bridge (Forest Reefs Road)

• The tenderer has been notified, and is currently preparing the required design and construction documentation for approval prior to construction commencing following the Christmas shutdown.

Land Development

Cook Street (11 Lot subdivision)

• Cowra Council has peer reviewed the assessment and proposed consent conditions for the subdivision. It is anticipated a report will be prepared for Council consideration in early 2015.

Wastewater

 IWCM – The Councils (CTW, Weddin, Cabonne and Blayney) involved in the joint IWCM have received concurrence from NSW Office of Water, for the joint Integrated Water Cycle Management (IWCM) Detailed Strategy. The approved document shall now be delivered to Councils by Hydroscience Consulting. Councils will seek to recover the subsidy provided by NOW for the project.

Recreation and Environment

Napier Street Toilet Block

• Contractor continues to progress project with completion programmed prior to Christmas.

Showground Building Upgrades

Contractor has completed project.

King George Oval Building Upgrades

- Council is awaiting advice on structural loading implications on the grandstands, with a report expected shortly.
- Bathurst Regional Council has considered and approved a report to provide the seats from Carrington Park, Bathurst for use at King George Oval. Arrangements will be made for collection, as and when mutually convenient.

Plant Replacement Program

• Water cart replacement – Water carts have been delivered and have been well utilised including at the Millamolong bush fire response.
