Discussions took place regarding different models and scenarios that may result if amalgamations proceed. The Chairperson and Cr Davis advised that in the current climate it would be appropriate to wait until a firm decision was passed in regards to amalgamations before investigating models and scenarios.

Mr Maunder advised if Member Councils were interested they could investigate other libraries' agreements, and convey specific ideas of the particular model they would like to consider to Manager Central West Libraries. It was suggested that member councils include it as a discussion item on the agenda for the August meeting. This would allow enough time for accounting staff to have details available for the next meeting of Central West Libraries in October 2016.
