What are Blayney's emerging sectors?

While Blayney Shire has a strong background in heritage and agriculture, the area is emerging as an employment base with a trend towards mining with the Cadia and Ridgeway Gold/Copper mines. The development of Blayney as a Cold Store Warehouse centre is gaining momentum, coupled with the road rail inter modal terminal.

Major employers in the region include: Nestle Purina, Cadia-Ridgeway Mine, Western White Linen and Blayney Foods.
