What does resident workforce by industry and occupation tell us?

This data helps identify local workforce skills and the potential for skills development to not only provide new job opportunities for residents but also identify opportunities for the expansion of local businesses and the relocation of new businesses.

What does Blayney's resident workforce by industry tell us?

Those sectors currently employing the most Blayney's residents according to Census 2011 data are Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing followed by Health Care and Social Assistance and Mining. The industries highlighted in Table 3.0 below show increases in the numbers of resident workers within

those industries between 2006 and 2011 as follows:
