Dear Residents,

**Re: Proposal for One Way Traffic on Adelaide Lane**



Following residents feedback, Council is proposing to change Adelaide Lane between Ogilvy and Church Streets to one-way traffic, travelling south. Feedback from residents cited safety concerns regarding site distances turning onto Ogilvy Street and width of the road.

Council presented a report with the proposal to the Blayney Shire Council Traffic Committee Meeting held 13 June 2025 and subsequently the recommendation was endorsed by Council at the June 2025 Ordinary Meeting.

Council is now seeking comment on the proposal to implement **one-way for Adelaide Lane** between **Ogilvy and Church Streets**, with traffic flow in a **southerly direction** only.
