

# Waste Management Facility



The Blayney Waste Management Facility (BWMF) is where a number of key waste management operations take place, and is a valuable tool in waste diversion and resource recovery. This is where the contents of Blayney's kerbside general waste bins are landfilled, plus it is a drop off point for excess household recycling and garden waste.



## Is Construction & Demolition waste accepted?

Yes! Inert materials such as bricks, tile, concrete and plasterboard can be dropped off at the Blayney Waste Management Facility for a fee. It is important to ensure that these are separated from other building materials, such as scrap steel, prior to arriving at the site, so they can be recycled.

Using the Waste Management Facility's recycling facilities is advantageous in many ways – not only can this material be recycled and reused instead of landfilled, but landfill fees are a lot higher than recycling fees. This means that builders and contractors, or residents with domestic building projects, can reduce costs and increase profits by choosing to separate and recycle where possible, rather than sending material to landfill.

The Blayney Waste Management Facility is located at 4165 Mid-Western Highway, Blayney and is open Monday to Friday 9:00am-5:00pm, and on the weekends from 9:00am-12:00pm and from 2:00pm-5:00pm. For general enquiries, phone: 6368 2104.

## What can I take to the Blayney Waste Management Facility?

The following items can be dropped off for recycling:

### *Free of charge*

- Household recyclables (plastics, glass, aluminium, steel, paper and cardboard)
- Residential green waste
- E-waste – any electrical items with a power cord or battery operated
- Clean fill
- Chemical containers via DrumMuster
- Scrap metal/motor vehicles
- Household problem waste (batteries, light bulbs and fluorescent tubes, smoke detectors and gas bottles)

### *Charges apply*

- Tyres
- Mattresses

The following items can be dropped off for disposal:

### *Charges apply*

- Mixed waste for landfill
- Timber
- Building waste, including bricks and concrete
- Commercial waste
- Lounges
- Animal carcasses
- Asbestos (subject to prior arrangement with Council. Must be wetted, double wrapped in plastic and transported separately with the load safely secured)

## Prohibited items

Council is not permitted to accept the following items at the Blayney Waste Management Facility:

- Pharmacy or clinical waste
- Radioactive waste
