WESTERN NSW ROAD PLAN - PHASE 2

The Western NSW Road Plan (Phase 2) requires each Council to nominate up to three road development or road rehabilitation projects that will increase road-freight productivity, create strategic links, support tourism and improve road safety. Projects that aim to eliminate constraint points in the regional road network are also to be submitted.

The project process will be as follows:

Ms Jenny Bennett, Executive Officer at CENTROC will follow your progress and ensure you meet the deadlines. Ms Jenny Bennett, Executive Officer at CENTROC will collect and auspice the funds until project completion.

I note that we have set a very short time frame and therefore it is important to re-emphasize the nature of this exercise: *to create a portfolio of Council prioritized road projects*. It is not necessary to spend excessive time completing your data forms and while being descriptive, please keep your answers succinct, quantitative and objective. Following Phase 1, it was recommended Councils allocate 2 to 5 hours to the data forms.

We need to maintain the project timelines in order to collate the data and provide the review committee ample time to prioritise the projects. Project completion is required by late August / early September 2013.

Dear Mayor,

In Opposition I initiated a Barwon Electorate Roads Project to encourage Councils to create a portfolio of roads to create strategic links and support productivity including mining, agriculture, freight and tourism. This was done with the view that presenting a strategic roads plan for the region will be more effective than smaller, individual applications.

Following my initial letter to you regarding the Western NSW Road Plan for Phase 2, we have received expressions of interest from 42 councils.

Jillian Kilby will be requesting a contribution for conducting the work on behalf of the councils. The contribution made by councils for Phase 1 was higher than will be required for Phase 2. This is due to economies of scale.

This project will be owned by the councils and I will continue to lobby on your behalf to both the state and federal governments. Minister Gay has already begun to use Phase 1 as a blue print for his limited resources. Transport for NSW will also be using the Plan to assist in shaping the Regional Transport Plans- please keep this in mind when engaging with Ms Kilby and Transport for NSW.

We are aiming to have Phase 2 of the Plan completed by September this year. Ms Kilby has developed template forms and a timeline for this target.

I believe this is a wonderful long term project which will assist Western NSW in receiving their fair share over the next 15 years.






