Frequently Asked Questions

How do l Recycle, Swap, Go my recycling bin? Simply return your full Recycle, Swap, Go bin to the Blayney Waste Facility to receive another empty bin.

Can I swap my green lid (garbage) bin?

The Recycle, Swap, Go initiative is only available for recyclables. Please continue to dispose of garbage in the rubbish bin or at the Blayney Waste Facility.

Do I have to buy a second bin to start Recycle, Swap, Go? No, there is no fee associated with Recycle, Swap, Go. Simply visit the Blayney Waste Facility to collect a bin and continue recycling..

I already have old yellow lidded bins. Can I use these to Recycle, Swap, Go? Yes you can, just visit the Blayney Waste Facility to swap bin for bin.

I do not receive Council's kerbside collection service can I participate? Yes, the Recycle, Swap, Go initiative is available to all Blayney Shire residents.

I am part of Council's kerbside collection service can I participate? Yes, simply collect a Recycle, Swap, Go bin from Blayney Waste Facility.

I own a business can I participate? Yes, simply collect a Recycle, Swap, Go branded bin from Blayney Waste Facility and return the bin when it is full of recyclables.

How does it work?

Recycle, Swap, Go is an initiative of Blayney Shire Council. Recycle, Swap, Go has been designed to make recycling for Blayney Shire residents even easier by streamlining the recycling process and allowing surplus recyclable material to be moved on.

Simply fill any old 240L wheelie bin that you have (ensure the bin is not part of the current J R Richards kerbside collection) with recyclable materials, deliver it to the Blayney Waste Facility, and you will be given another old 240L bin to fill again.

The program is for recyclable material only. Bins returned containing any general waste will be charged at the applicable cost.

What you need to know

Recycling bins provided through the Recycle, Swap, Go program will not be picked up as part of the domestic kerbside collection service.

Recycle, Swap, Go bins must be returned to the Blayney Waste Facility and exchanged for another Recycle, Swap, Go marked bin.

Do not Recycle, Swap, Go your kerbside yellow lidded recycling bin. These bins are serial coded and identified by Council's waste collection contractor.

The Recycle, Swap, Go initiative does not replace existing recycling services.



What can be recycled?

- Paper: office paper, magazines, newspapers and junk mail
- Cardboard
- ✓ Green, clear and brown glass bottles and jars
- ✓ Juice and milk cartons
- ✓ All plastic bottles and containers marked, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6 but no lids please
- Steel (tin) and aluminium cans and empty aerosols

What can't be recycled?

- X Plastic bags or recyclables inside plastic bags
- X Disposable nappies
- 🗶 Garden waste
- ✗ Polystyrene (foam)
- X Syringes or medical waste
- 🗶 Dead animals
- 🗙 Oils
- X Ceramics, ovenware or light bulbs
