




SCHEMATIC DESIGN




LEGEND

- 01 Dry creek
- 02 Existing shelters + path
- 03 Cut back reeds to allow greater access to water
- 04 Deco granite path to deck
- 05 Viewing deck
- 06 Entry feature/ sign
- 07 Existing poplars to be retained
- 08 Shelter / bird hide with seating
- 09 Stabilisation + embankment works as needed
- 10 Remove existing Elm + Willow trees, retain any natives where possible, re-vegetate with new trees and endemic native planting
- 11 Timber bridge
- 12 Bound gravel circular path
- 13 Future footpath connection
- 14 Gross Pollutant Traps (GPT) to capture contaminants before entering the creek
- 15 Formalised parking along Henry St and Burns St
- 16 Park bench for peaceful contemplation




